Terms of Reference of Sectoral Working Groups:

- Take complete stock of interventions/activities of their relevant sector(s) implemented from 2013 to 2023. (as per the prescribed template).
- Take stock of ongoing interventions/activities within the province/territory, indicating achievements during the current year (2024) (as per the prescribed template).
- List down key priorities of climate change adaptation and mitigation for the next decade (up to the year 2035), keeping the Balochistan Climate Change Policy and action plans in view.
- Develop at least five concept notes for each of the identified climate change adaptation and mitigation priority interventions within their respective jurisdictional mandate (in the prescribed template) for exploring international climate finance.
- Share complete information with B4C for Balochistan-level consolidation and further reporting/process as may be required.
- The Working Group shall meet twice a month or earlier as may be necessary to discuss and review the progress on the assigned tasks.
